

ARTICLE XI: Cabrillo Club Standing Committees

Section 8. The composition and duties for each standing committee are as follows:

- B. The Americanization Committee shall:
 - a. Support and, when possible, coordinate activities with the member(s) the members of the Americanization Committee from each of the Subordinate clubs;
 - b. Promote good citizenship, study legislation pending before the California Legislature and United States Congress, particularly those matters pertaining to immigration; and
 - c. Monitor matters which pertain to the welfare of American Citizens, result in a benefit to California products or industry and alert the State Board of Directors to any matter which may support or undermine the ideals of Cabrillo Club.
