Application must be fully completed or applicant will be disqualified. No applications will be accepted, or will be considered, if the required documents are not attached and the following requirements met:

1. Students must be of Portuguese descent on father's or mother's side, be a USA citizen or permanent resident.
2. Maintained a minimum of 3.50 grade point average in high school (Grades 9-12) and be a graduating senior of a California high school. **Transcript of grade records must accompany application.**
3. Meet all requirements set down by an accredited university or college of the student's choice.
4. Participated in at least **three** extra-curricular activities while in high school.
5. **Present three letters of recommendation from individuals who will vouch for the applicant's academic standing, character and personality. At least one of these letters must be from the Principal, Dean or Counselor, verifying participation in the extracurricular activities. One letter must be from a Teacher of the high school attended.**

The third letter may be from any other source except a relative. Individuals writing letters are to include their titles or position.

Awards are made on a competitive basis, consideration being given to scholastic attainment, character, and promise. The intent of the donors of this fund is to assist students of Portuguese descent who have a desire to secure an education. Scholarships in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) each will be awarded to **Scholarship Recipients**, upon **verification of enrollment** in an accredited community college, college or university, or trade school. All applicants will be notified by June 30 of the status of their applications. Additionally, those individuals who are awarded a Scholarship will receive award instructions. This application is for the use of students applying for admittance in any accredited college, trade school, or university in the U.S.A.

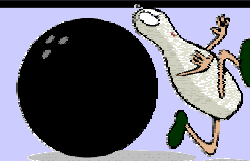

NOTES FROM OUR 2009 SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

I wanted to update you now that I've completed my first semester at Fresno Pacific University. I have had an amazing experience so far at college. and have had outstanding growth both academically and spiritually. I was able to declare my major in English, completed five classes successfully, and managed to have fun doing so. Also, with the Advanced Placement credit from classes taken at Clovis High School, I will be entered into the Spring semester as a sophomore.

Last semester, my course study consisted of the Principles of Math, Principles of Leadership, Honors Ancient Civilizations, Jesus and the Christian Community, and Hebrew. All were challenging in their own ways (especially Hebrew), and have received straight A's with the exception of Hebrew, which has yet to be posted. My most rewarding class last semester would be Hebrew. The professor, Brian Schultz is one of the leading scholars concerning the Dead Sea Scrolls, lived in Israel for over a decade, and teaches the class with the "immersion" method, meaning that 90% of the course is in spoken Biblical Hebrew. After approximately three months, I am capable of reading Hebrew script, understanding complete conversations in Biblical Hebrew, as well as recite some of the "Shema" (the Hebrew equivalent of The Lord's Prayer).

I just want to thank you for your support through a scholarship. Though I appreciate the Winter break and an enjoying family time, I am thoroughly excited to attack the new semester and get back to campus life.

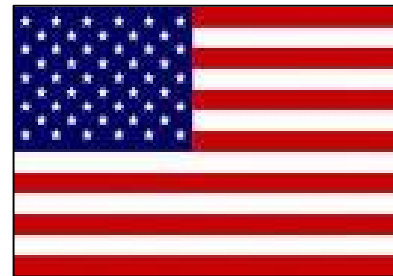

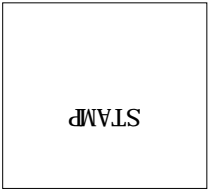
