## 2010 Scholarships

*Tulare #12 recently hosted the annual screening of 189 scholarship applications received through Cabrillo Civic Clubs' State Scholarship program, which resulted in 157 scholarships at \$500.00 each being awarded throughout the State of California.*

*Of the 189 applications received, 21 were from the counties supported by San Diego #16 with 16 being awarded from this area. The increased number of local applicants is due to the many hours, dedication and passion that the members of the San Diego club gave to the Scholarship Program. San Diego #16 is to be commended for its hard work and loyalty to the State Scholarship program. It is the individual devotion of each member that allows this program to be so successful!*

*The basic criteria used in screening a scholarship application and determining a scholarship award is based upon academic performance, extra curricular activities, promise, leadership, work (paid or volunteer) and letters of recommendation. There is an additional advantage given to those students whose parent(s) are member(s) of a local Cabrillo Civic Club. This additional advantage proved to be an attractive choice for students this year, as 53 applicants' parent(s) joined their local club, thus confirming the family's desire to promote the Portuguese heritage and increase their scholarship award potential!*
