President's Day



George Washington was born February 11, 1731,
according to the Julian calendar.

In 1752, Britain and her colonies adopted
Gregorian calendar, jumping ahead 11 days,
making January the first month of the year
instead of March.

According to the new calendar,
Washington's Birthday changed to Feb 22, 1732.
The celebration of Washington's Birthday has a
history as old as our country.

It was celebrated publicly for the first time
in the late 18th century, while Washington
was still president.

The celebration became official in 1885, when
President Chester Arthur signed a bill making his
birthday a federal holiday. In 1968, Congress passed
the Monday Holiday Act which moved the
observance from Feb 22nd to the
third Monday of the month.

Many Americans believe that President's Day
celebrates both Washington and Lincoln.
Lincoln's birthday has never been declared a
national holiday, but is celebrated in many states.

We also celebrate Abe Lincoln in February!
